



## How do I know what taxonomy code to use?

1. If you are a licensed health care provider such as a Nurse, Speech Therapist, Physical Therapist, you will enter the taxonomy that most closely relates to your discipline.
2. If you are an independent practitioner enrolled as an ASL, Developmental, Hearing, Orientation and Mobility or Vision Specialist, an Autism or Behavior Disorders Teacher or Service Coordinator you will use the **Early Intervention taxonomy code (252Y00000X)**.
3. If you work under an agency, and are enrolled as a Service Coordinator, please work with your agency to apply for your NPI Taxonomy Code. You will use the **“Case Manager/Care Coordinator” taxonomy code (171M00000X)**.
4. If you work under an agency, and are enrolled as an ASL, Developmental, Hearing, Orientation and Mobility or Vision Specialist, an Autism or Behavior Disorders Teacher, please work with your agency to apply for your NPI Taxonomy Code. You will use the **“Specialist” taxonomy code (174400000X)**.
